PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Parking around the school:

The 'back paddock' - part of this is now a Sale of Asset. The funds derived from this are being used in a combination of funding for the building of 6 new classrooms and to renovate the toilet block. As such, **the only entry for car parking to the back paddock will eventually be Goodwin Street.** I have arranged to move the western OOSH fence 10 metres to the east to increase parking in this area. Realize that the DET **does not supply car parks for parents.**

They only supply car parks for **staff.**

The car parking restriction in Goodwin Street states NO PARKING, 8:00 - 9:30 am and NO PARKING, 2:30 - 4:00pm. I phoned Warringah Council's Rangers and this is their response. You can park there during the stated hours **as long as you stay within your vehicle.** If you leave the vehicle ie move away from it more than 3 metres you will be booked. As such this area in Goodwin Street does act as a **'kiss and drop'** zone. Please use it as such. It also needs you to move so that other parents can access it.

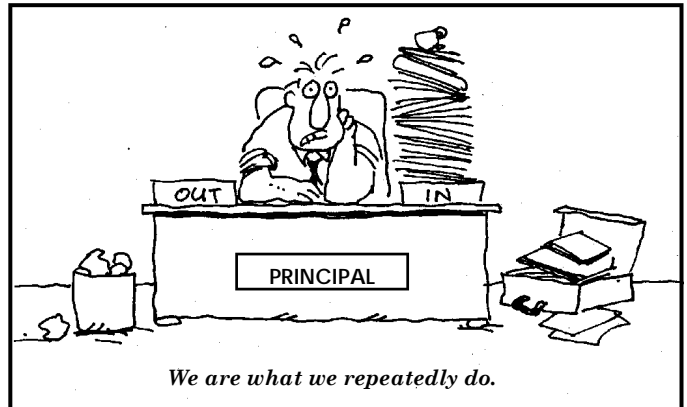
For parking of a longer duration or when you need to leave the vehicle and come into the school the options remain as:-

- The 'back paddock'
- Local streets where parking is not restricted .
- The council car park in Ocean Street and walk across to the school.
- The council car park at the end of Goodwin Street ie 'Duck Park' and walk up to the school.

Realise that anyone parking on school grounds, ie the 'back paddock', does so at their own risk. The aim is to eventually have the reconfigured 'back paddock car park' completely covered in bitumen and marked out with delineated car spaces. As the staff car park now has 2 demountable classrooms sited in it more staff cars will be accessing the 'back paddock'. Once the new two storey building is built then the demountables may be removed and increase staff parking on the main site and thus aid parent car parking in the 'back paddock'.

Remember, the DET does not supply parent car parking.
